



Needles: 4.5-5.0 mm, 40 cm cable / long cable for magic loop.

Yarn: 250-200 meter / 100 gr (heavy DK - worsted), black color.

Abbreviations

BOR = beginning of round

P = purl

Sl m = slip marker

Dec = decrease

Rep = repeat

St / Sts = stitch / stitches

K = knit

Rnd = round

K3tog - knit 3 stitches together

RS = right side

Instructions

CO 100 sts.

Place a BOR marker, begin working RIB pattern in the round as foll: *K1, P1; rep from * to BOR. Cont RIB until piece meas 24 cm from cast on.

Setup rnd: Place a marker every 20 sts to mark dec position. (5 markers in total)

Rnd 1 - dec rnd: * work in rib to 3 sts before m, K3tog, sl m; rep from * to BOR - 10 sts decd.

Rnd 2: Work sts as they appear (the st before each m is a knit st, not a purl st).

Rep rnds 1-2 until 20 sts rem, 4 sts between every two markers. End with rnd 2.

Next rnd - dec rnd: *K1, K3tog; rep from * to BOR - 10 sts rem

Finishing: cut yarn leave a 20 cm tail. Thread yarn on a tapestry needle, beg with the first st of the row and end with the last st, thread the yarn through all sts.

weave in the ends. The hat should have a folded hem, so make sure to weave in the cast on tail to the RS of the hat. the folded hem will cover it.

Send the finish hat to the pickup center close to you.
